

THE GIFT OF GIVING

In Paul's letter to the Corinthians (2 Cor 8), he links the joyfulness of people with the fact that they gave. What's more, he writes that they 'urgently pleaded for the privilege of sharing in this act of service.' We probably couldn't say that we've ever 'urgently pleaded to give'

There are various reasons that someone may give: out of love, perhaps a sense of duty, maybe because somebody has asked for help. All of these are good, and we believe that the act of giving has a profound impact upon the giver, maybe more so than the gift ever cost.

In Luke 6:38, Jesus promised us that we would be blessed when we give: "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap; for the measure you give will be the measure you get back."

Generosity is at the heart of our faith, we believe in a generous God and our own generosity is a testament and hallmark of our faith in action, whether it be in time, attention, talents, abilities, knowledge, or money.

The ministry and mission of Christ Church with St Mary's is largely funded through the incredible generosity of those who give to it.

Over the last year, your generous giving has enabled us to continue to run the two churches, community centre, and burial grounds and provide valuable resources to:

- The local Old Town community and parish.
- Continue our work together with the churches in the Old Town partnership.
- Enhance the mission and ministry of fellow Anglican churches in the Bristol Diocese with a generous £105K donation via the Parish Share scheme.
- Outreach and support to local primary and secondary schools.
- Offering traditional services for life events like baptisms, marriage, blessings, funerals, memorial and bereavement services.
- Community centre which provides education, leisure, social and entertainment facilities to our community.
- Tackling loneliness through our regular afternoon teas, walking groups, Alone at Christmas meals, and chaplaincy visits to residential homes.
- Special community services, concerts, and events.
- Maintaining the church building as one of the best kept heritage buildings in Swindon.
- Paying the salaries of employed team members.
- Improving the local environment through our Eco Church program.

THE NEED

OUR PART IN THE COMMUNITY AND THE MISSION OF THE CHURCH

At the centre of everything we do is the love of God. Our mission is to proclaim Christ through teaching and example, serving the needs of local people and becoming a central meeting place for a whole variety of community activities.

The PCC has defined its goals for the year; and we would greatly appreciate your support in helping us to make the following a reality:

- Presenting the Christian Faith, both traditionally and through new ways through Fellowship of Faith, services, events, and activities for the local community.
- Consolidate the management of the site (church, community centre and burial board) to improve stewardship, efficiency, and communication.
- Develop our work of supporting children, young families, and schools.
- Fully engage the new Bristol Diocesan strategy 'Transforming Church Together' and forming new mission partnerships with Wroughton, Wichelstowe, Parks and Walcot.
- Continue development of the Christ Church site as a place of remembrance, peace and reflection at the heart of Old Town.
- Continue our careful stewardship of our site's natural resources, to encourage wildlife and plant diversity and care for God's creation.

We don't receive grants or subsidies from the Anglican church or government. Funds to sustain our church and community work rely solely on regular donations, legacies, and fundraising.

It costs over £350K per year to run Christ Church, St Mary's and the Community Centre and, due to steep increases in energy and other costs this year, we expect a £30k shortfall in funding this year.
